Report on the Financial Statement

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of CNI-SBSS, which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2015, and the Income & Expenditure Account for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position and financial performance of the Institution in accordance with the Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, to the extent applicable.
